

Subj: New Polling on Minneapolis

From January 9-10, we collected 11,021 survey responses via online web panel, weighted to 2026 likely voters. Key takeaways from this research:

- **The shooting of Renee Good by ICE in Minnesota has broken through with voters.** 61% say they have heard "a lot" about the shooting, with 86% saying at least "a little. 76% of voters say that they have seen video footage.
- **Voters' approval of Trump's handling of this situation is deeply underwater** – with a net approval of -19 percentage points overall and -23pp among swing voters.
 - This is a more squarely negative reaction that voters have had to similar moments earlier in the term – approval for deploying the National Guard in Los Angeles was just net -6.
- **The circumstances of the shooting are shaping voters' reactions.** When forced to choose, 50% say the agent used excessive force vs. 35% who say he acted appropriately – a 15-point gap against the administration's account.
 - In a three-way split: 38% call the shooting unjustified, 26% want further investigation, and just 25% back the administration's self-defense claim. Three-quarters of voters won't defend the shooting outright.
- **When putting this event through an explicitly partisan lens, voters look deeply divided.** In questions pitting Democratic statements against Republican statements about the event, voters are split anywhere from -1pp in favor of GOP statements to +2pp in favor of Democratic statements.
- **There is tension in the data in that voters break against Trump on this specific incident, but remain with him (and against Democrats) on the broader issue of immigration.**
- **Trump's job approval on immigration remains the highest of all issues** in our ongoing monitoring of approval across various issues, although it has declined 1pp in recent days. Approval on this issue sits just below water today at net -2pp.
 - In contrast, his approval on the cost of living – voters' top issue priority – is at net -16pp.
- **Further, voters still have substantially more trust of the GOP than Democrats on immigration.** When asking a basic question of which party voters trust to enforce immigration laws, 38% trust Dems vs. 47% who trust the GOP.
 - Even when framed around this particular event, the GOP maintains a trust advantage (42/44).
- **Abolishing ICE has wider support than it has in the past, but is still a minority view.** Voters say that "we should keep ICE as it is... to keep dangerous criminals out of our communities" by 2pp overall (44/42) over "abolish ICE... and replace it with an immigration system that focuses on real security threats while treating people humanely." Swing voters pick "keep ICE" by 10pp.
- **Some Democratic proposals have much more support** when presented without counterarguments:
 - Requiring warrants for arrest at +29pp
 - Prohibiting masks on agents at +16pp
 - Keeping border patrol at the border at +8pp
- **That said, when putting those policies in context of Democratic and Republican arguments, the advantage shrinks** – although remains above water at +3pp (46/43), with support +3pp among swing voters and +9pp among non-2024 voters.

- Taken together, the data shows the President and his party on the wrong side of public opinion around the Minneapolis shooting. However, the trust deficit Democrats face on immigration constrains our ability to move voters, even in this specific incident where public opinion is largely on our side.

Some Democrats in Congress are proposing changes to Immigration and Customs Enforcement (ICE), including limiting their use of firearms, requiring ICE agents to wear identification and remain unmasked during enforcement operations, and requiring DHS to obtain warrants before they make any arrests.
