Tariff Message Test

September 9, 2025

Survey data for this research includes 1,529 responses from surveys, collected nationally via online web panel September 8-9, 2025.

Key Findings

The most effective anti-Trump messaging combines tariff impacts with healthcare
cost concerns. The Tariffs + Healthcare message tested in the 100th percentile, the
most effective anti-Trump message we've tested across 800+ messages, and is
extremely persuasive at increasing House vote choice towards Democrats. This
combination successfully frames Trump's economic policies as directly threatening
voters' most essential needs - affordable groceries and accessible healthcare.

- A corruption-focused message on tariffs, which did not include healthcare, was also
 effective, testing in the 88th percentile on Trump disapproval, though somewhat
 less effective on House vote choice.
- While less effective, the versions of the tariffs message that focus on authoritarianism and corruption are still very effective at increasing Trump disapproval, and somewhat effective at increasing Democratic support for the House.

- These alternative messages were more effective with Harris and college-educated white voters at increasing House Democratic support than with Trump voters and non-college whites, suggesting that these variants are best suited for building elite support.
- The cost-focused variants are more effective with the electorate overall.
- An authoritarian-only variant (styled after Ezra Klein's op-ed), which did not mention healthcare costs or tariffs, was the least effective message from this test.
